Teacher Education - Centrally sponsored Scheme Setting up of District Institutes of Education and Training under Phase III Orders Issued.

ORDER:-

The Government of India have formulated - Centrally sponsored scheme of Teacher Education to help States to establish premier institutes of Teacher Education in each district called District Institutes of Education and Training to improve and enrich the professional equipment of elementary school teachers, non formal and adult education functionaries and other personnel. Under Phase I and Phase II of the implementation of the project 14 districts have been covered and 14 District Institutes of Education and Training have been established. Now, under Phase III the Government of India have approved establishment of District Institutes of Education and Training in 7 remaining districts. The Government of India have released the grant for non recurring expenditure towards construction of buildings amounting to Rs. 442 lakhs. The buildings for the District Institutes of Education and Training have now been constructed. The Director of Teacher Education Research and Training has requested orders of the Government for the sanction of the District Institutes of Education and Training and for the sanction of posts for various categories of staff in the institutes.

2. The Government of Tamilnadu accept the assistance sanctioned by the Government of India and approve the opening of seven District Institutes of Education and Training in 1992-93 in the following districts and in the places mentioned against each:

Every District Institute of Education and Training will have the following seven academic branches and an administrative section.

- i) Pre service Teacher Education
- ii) In service Programmes and Extension services.
- iii) District Resource Unit for Adult Education and Non formal Education.
- iv) Planning and Management
- v) Educational Technology
- vi) Work Experience
- vii) Curriculum and Evaluation
- viii) Administration.

3. Sanction is accorded to the creation of the following posts in the scale of pay indicated for each of the seven District Institutes of Education and Training and the posts shall be for the seven branches of the District Institutes of Education and Training as mentioned in the annexure to this order.

4. Sanction is also accorded to the creation of 7 (seven) posts of Superintendents for the administrative branch at the rate of one post for each of the seven District Institutes of Education and Training on the scale of pay of Rs. 1600-50-2300-75-3200.

5. The posts newly sanctioned in paragraphs 3 and 4 above shall be temporary and shall be for a period of one year from the date of filling up of the posts.

6. The Government direct that the seven District Institutes of Education and Training shall have the following posts also and they shall not, however, be newly sanctioned but shall be transferred from other departments as indicated below:

(i) Librarians:-

Seven posts of Librarians shall be transferred to the District Institutes of Education and Training from the...

Tamil Nadu Archives where there are surplus posts. Seven Librarians from the Archives shall also be redeployed in the District Institutes of Education and Training in the above transferred posts of Librarians. The Commissioner of Archives and Historical Research is requested to transfer the surplus Librarians to the Director of Teacher Education, Research and Training for redeployment in the District Institutes of Education and Training. He is requested to intimate details of the posts so transferred such as the Government Order in which they were originally sanctioned and the period upto which their temporary continuance has been sanctioned.

(ii) Assistant, Typist and Office Assistant: Out of the posts rendered surplus consequent on the closure of the State Adult Education Programme/Rural Functional Literacy Project, the following number of posts shall be transferred to the ~~seven~~ District Institutes of Education and Training.* Individuals from the Non-Formal and Adult Education Department who have become surplus consequent on the winding up of State Adult Education Programme and Rural Functional Literacy Project shall be redeployed in the above posts. The Director of Non-Formal and Adult Education is requested to take action in this regard.

*Accordingly the following posts shall be transferred to the ~~seven~~ Dist. Institute of ~~Primary~~ Education and Training.

(iii) Post of Junior Assistant: The closure of the State Adult Education Programme/Rural Functional Literacy Project and the consequent absorption of posts of Assistants rendered surplus will result in reversion and the posts of Junior Assistants being rendered surplus in the Directorate of School Education and its Unit Offices. Hence, 28 posts of Junior Assistants shall be transferred to the District Institutes of Education and Training at the rate of four for each D.I.E.T. from the posts rendered surplus consequent on the winding up of Rural Functional Literacy Project/State Adult Education Programme and accordingly 28 Junior Assistants shall be redeployed in the District Institutes of Education and Training. The Director of Teacher Education Research and Training/Director of School Education/

Director of Non-Formal and Adult Education are requested to take necessary further action with reference to posts mentioned under item (ii) and (iii) above. The details of the posts so transferred to the District Institutes of Education and Training such as the G.O. in which they were originally sanctioned and the period upto which their temporary continuance has been ordered shall be intimated to the Government.

7. The Principals of the District Institutes of Education and Training in the seven places mentioned in paragraph 2 above shall henceforth function as new Heads of Offices under the control of the concerned Treasuries/Sub-Treasuries. The Treasury Officers are requested to admit the salary and other bills presented by the Principals of the newlyformed District Institutes of Education and Training-treating these orders as Express Pay Orders.

8. The expenditure should be debited to the following head of account. "2202. General Education - 02. Secondary Education - 105. Teacher Training - Scheme in the Eighth Five Year Plan - III. Centrally sponsored SA. Setting up of District Institutes of Education and Training in Tamil Nadu (DFC 2202 02 105 SA 0000)".

9. The Director of Teacher Education, Research and Training is requested to send proposals for providing additional funds in Final Modified Appropriation 1992-93.

10. The Director of Teacher Education, Research and Training is requested to ensure that the conditions stipulated by the Government of India in paragraph 4 of their letter are strictly adhered to. The Director of Teacher Education, Research and Training is also requested to take immediate steps to get the assistance from Government of India for a five year period in as much as the policy was contemplated to be implemented in a five year time frame.
