TEACHER EDUCATION-Centrally sponsored scheme of Restructuring and organization of teacher education-Setting up of 8 District Institutes of Education and Training in Tamil Nadu-Orders-Issued.

ORDER:

Under the Centrally sponsored scheme of Restructuring and Reorganization of Teacher Education, 21 District Institutes of Education and Training (DIET) have been set up in each of 21 Districts in the State. In order to cover all the districts in this State, it has been suggested before the State Level Empowered Committee, constituted already for this purpose, to establish 8 more District Institutes of Education and Training in the State. The State Level Empowered Committee which met on 17.10.98 have resolved to recommend to Government of India for the establishment of 8 District Institutes of Education and Training in each of 8 districts where District Institutes of Education and Training are not available. Based on the recommendation of the State Level Empowered Committee, a Project Report was prepared as per the District Institutes of Education and Training guidelines and forwarded to Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Education for approval and release of funds. The Government of India, in their letters first read above, have conveyed their approval for the setting up of 8 District Institutes of Education and Training in the State. They have also conveyed their approval for the sanction of costs mentioned in Annexure to this order. The Central Assistance for the recurring items of these costs will be released by Government of India separately. They have also sanctioned an amount of Rs.406 lakh as 1st instalment towards non-recurring expenditure of Civil works which covers the construction of institution building, hostels and staff quarters. The Government of India have intimated that the balance amount of Central Assistance for the Civil works will be released on receipt of reports of projectwise utilization of grants from the State Government to the extent of 75% of the 1st instalment released and of corresponding physical progress of work.

2. The National Council for Teacher Education has also conveyed their provisional recognition for the year 1998-99 for the establishment of 8 new District Institutes of Education and Training.

3. The Government accept the assistance sanctioned by Government of India and approve the setting up of 8 District Institutes of Education and Training from the year 1998-99 in the following 8 Districts in the places mentioned against them.

Every District Institute of Education and Training will have the following 7 academic branches and an administrative section.

- i) Pre-Service Teacher Education (PST)
- ii) Inservice Programmes and Extension Services (IPES)
- iii) District Resource Unit for Adult and non-formal Education (DRU)
- iv) Planning and Management (P & M)
- v) Educational Technology (E.T.)
- vi) Work Experience (W.E.)
- vii) Curricular Management and Evaluation (C.M.E.)
- viii) Administration (Adm.)

4. Sanction is accorded to the creation of posts for each of the 7 academic branches mentioned in the annexure to this order for 8 District Institutes of Education and Training approved in para 3 above and the scale of pay applicable to these posts have been indicated. The qualification of staff shall be as per G.O. No. 105, School Education dated 15.8.97. There shall be all be continued till the end of the plan period i.e. on 31.3.2002.

5. Sanction is also accorded to the creation of the following posts for the administrative section in each of the 8 District Institutes of Education and Training in the scale of pay indicated against them.

These posts shall also be continued till the end of the plan period (i.e. on 31.3.2002).

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 2 above shall constitute an item of 'New Service' and necessary provision will be obtained by inclusion of the amount in the Final supplementary estimates for 1998-99 and approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending provision of funds, the expenditure will be met by an advance from the contingency fund. The Director of Teacher Education, Research and Training is requested to apply for the contingency fund advance to the Finance (H.U.I) Department in the prescribed format.

In regard to the sanction of amount of Rs. 400 lakhs towards Civil Works, orders have already been issued in G.O. No. 1230, Education dated 14.10.98. The construction of building for the 2 new District Institutes of Education and Training in the respective sites is in progress and it will take some more time to complete the building. Hence it is proposed to locate the new 2 District Institutes of Education and Training temporarily with only 5 academic branches in they year 1998-99 except the pre-service teacher education branch in the places mentioned against each of the Districts below:-

The pre-service teacher education branch will be opened in the year 1999-2000 as and when the construction of building provision of equipments are completed.

8. The Director of School Education is requested to issue suitable instruction to the Heads of High/Higher Secondary Schools to provide necessary accommodation for the starting of District Institutes of Education and Training temporarily.
