ABSTRACT

Education - Teacher Education - Secondary Grade Teachers Training in Karnataka State - Evaluation of Certificates of candidates who passed after 17.9.84 - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, the Government issued orders permitting the Director of School Education to evaluate the Karnataka State Teachers Training certificates subject to certain conditions. One of the conditions was that the candidates whose Certificates are to be so evaluated should have obtained 50% of marks in aggregate in their S.S.L.C. and should have obtained 50% marks in each subject in their T.T.C. examination as in the case of TamilNadu State Teacher Training Certificate holders. While disposing of a batch of writ petitions in the matter, the High Court, Madras in its orders in W.P.Nos.7286 and 3347 of 1982 and 255 of 1984 dated 28.11.84, held that it would be only in cases where evaluation is necessary after 17.9.84 that the criteria laid down in G.O.Ms. No.1286, Education, dated 17.9.84 would have to be considered. Subsequently, it has also been clarified in the Govt. letter 2nd read above, that the certificates of those who have written the training course examinations before 17.9.84 and failed, but subsequently passed their Karnataka Teacher Training Certificate examination can be evaluated as per the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.1236, Education dt.17.9.84, that is, only with reference to the 50% marks criteria laid down. There have been many representations from those who had undergone the training course upto the end of the academic year 1984-85 but passed the Karnataka State Teacher Training Certificate examination after issue of orders in the G.O. first read above prescribing 50% marks in S.S.L.C., T.S.L.C, etc. requesting that their certificates may also be evaluated as equivalent to the Certificates issued in Tamil Nadu.

2. The Government have carefully examined the requests in this regard and have decided that the Karnataka State Teacher Training Certificates of the remaining candidates thus left over may also be permitted to be evaluated. Accordingly the Government direct that the clarification issued in Govt. Lr.Ms.No.148, Edn. dt. 11.2.88 - namely, those who have

written the Training Course examinations before 17.9.84 and failed but subsequently passed the Karnataka Teacher Training Certificate examination can have their certificates evaluated as equivalent to the Secondary Grade Teacher Training Certificates issued in Tamil Nadu as per the orders issued in G.O.Ms.No.1256, Education, dated 17.9.84 - shall stand modified and the following orders are issued instead:-

1. The Karnataka State Teacher Training Certificates obtained after 17.9.84 by candidates who had undergone the training course upto the end of the academic year 1984-85 including the candidates studied in the second year of the course in the academic year 1984-85 the evaluated as equivalent to the Secondary Grade Teacher Training Certificates issued in Tamil Nadu in relaxation of the norms prescribed in G.O.Ms.No.1256, Education dated 17.9.84 as a special case after due verification. Such evaluation shall be done irrespective of the fact whether the candidate is temporarily employed or unemployed. The Teacher Training Certificates including the I year/II year certificates issued by the Karnataka Board prior to 17.9.84 showing the subjects in which they had failed should be duly submitted to the authority concerned for evaluation. //

3. The Government have also examined the question of relaxing the age rules in respect of the candidates whose certificates are ordered to be evaluated as above and who might have become overaged for purposes of employment and have decided to grant relaxation of rules relating to age. The Government accordingly direct that in respect of the candidates whose Karnataka State Teacher Training Certificates are evaluation as per these orders relaxation of the relevant rules relating to age qualification to granted wherever necessary.

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The Director of School Education and the Director of Elementary Education are requested to send consolidated proposals in this regard in due course.
